What is CAST?

CAST is a not-for-profit arts organisation. It is based in a large former school building in the centre of Helston, with entrances on Penrose Road and from the car park in Wendron Street.


The building provides studio spaces for twenty artists. It also has a Café serving delicious locally sourced food, a special black box screening space where artists' films are shown, learning spaces that host workshops for families and programmes for schools, a regular Saturday Club for 12 to 16 year-olds, and a new ceramics studio.

MULLION POLURRIAN COVE



WINDSOCKS, SAND-SHIFTERS AND SWIRLING SHOALS

From Mullion wander along Laflouder Lane to Polurrian Cove for a day of fun on the beach.

Join forces, shift sand and engineer dams and waterways in the stream. Make pilchard windsocks and move together like a shoal of fish.

We're bringing some treat buns, but be sure to bring a picnic and plenty to drink as the beach is remote and accessible only by footpath (there are no toilets).

Toilets: Public toilets on Lender Lane (past car park)

Parking: Mullion Village Car Park, Lender Lane
Bus: Lizard Adventurer (open-top bus) L1

Gather on the village green, opposite Gweek
Quay, where we'll be offering nautical inspiration
and expertise to make little boats of all kinds.

What makes a boat float? What goes on inside them? Rig a sail or say something with flags.

We're bringing some treat buns, but bring your own picnic, or buy lunch, supper, snacks or ice creams in the village.
