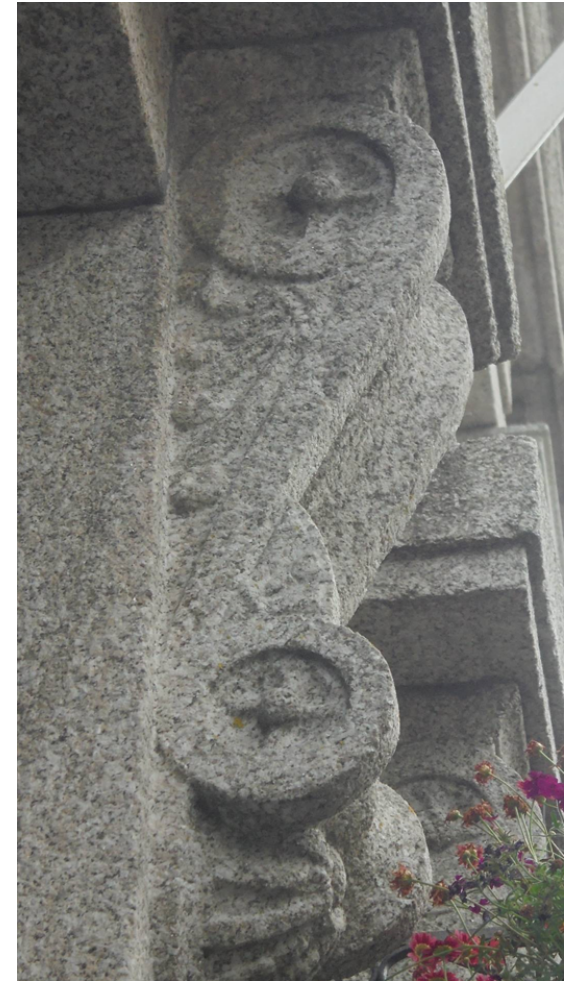

12. Where can you see this date?



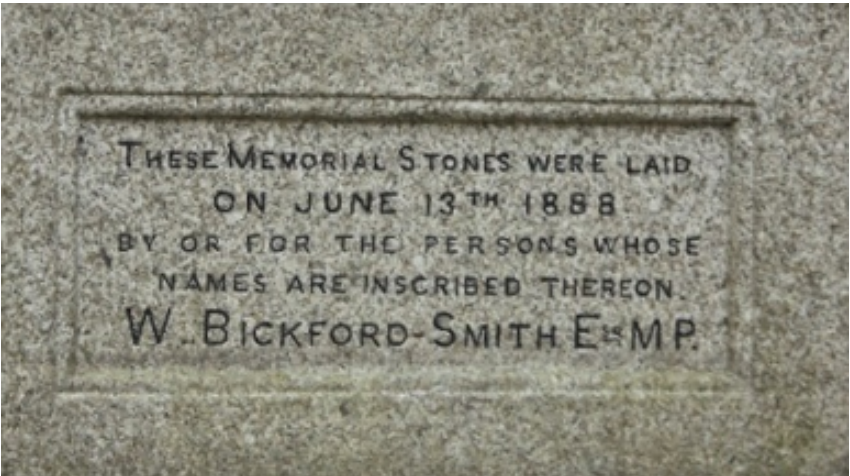
